Cost	Compare the costs of outsourcing to in-house logistics
Scope of Work	Determine which functions to outsource and which to keep in-house
Expertise	Evaluate the provider's experience, technology, and capabilities
Flexibility	Make sure the provider can adapt to your changing needs
Communication	Ensure there is clear communication and reporting
Risks and Security	Analyze the potential risks and security of outsourcing
