Book review

Writing a review involves (1) Summarizing and (ii) Evaluating a text

Summarizing means presenting the key ideas and points discussed **Evaluating** means analysing the strengths & weaknesses of the text

Structure of a critical Review

- (1)<u>Introduction</u>: Brief introduction about the author, title, purpose of the text, summary of the main arguments and a brief evaluation of the text.
- (2) <u>Summary</u>: The theme of the text with main points and a brief explanation of the objective of the author.
- (3) <u>Critique</u>: Balanced discussion and evaluation of the merits, drawbacks and notable features of the text.
- (4) <u>Conclusion</u>: Summary of the whole review.
