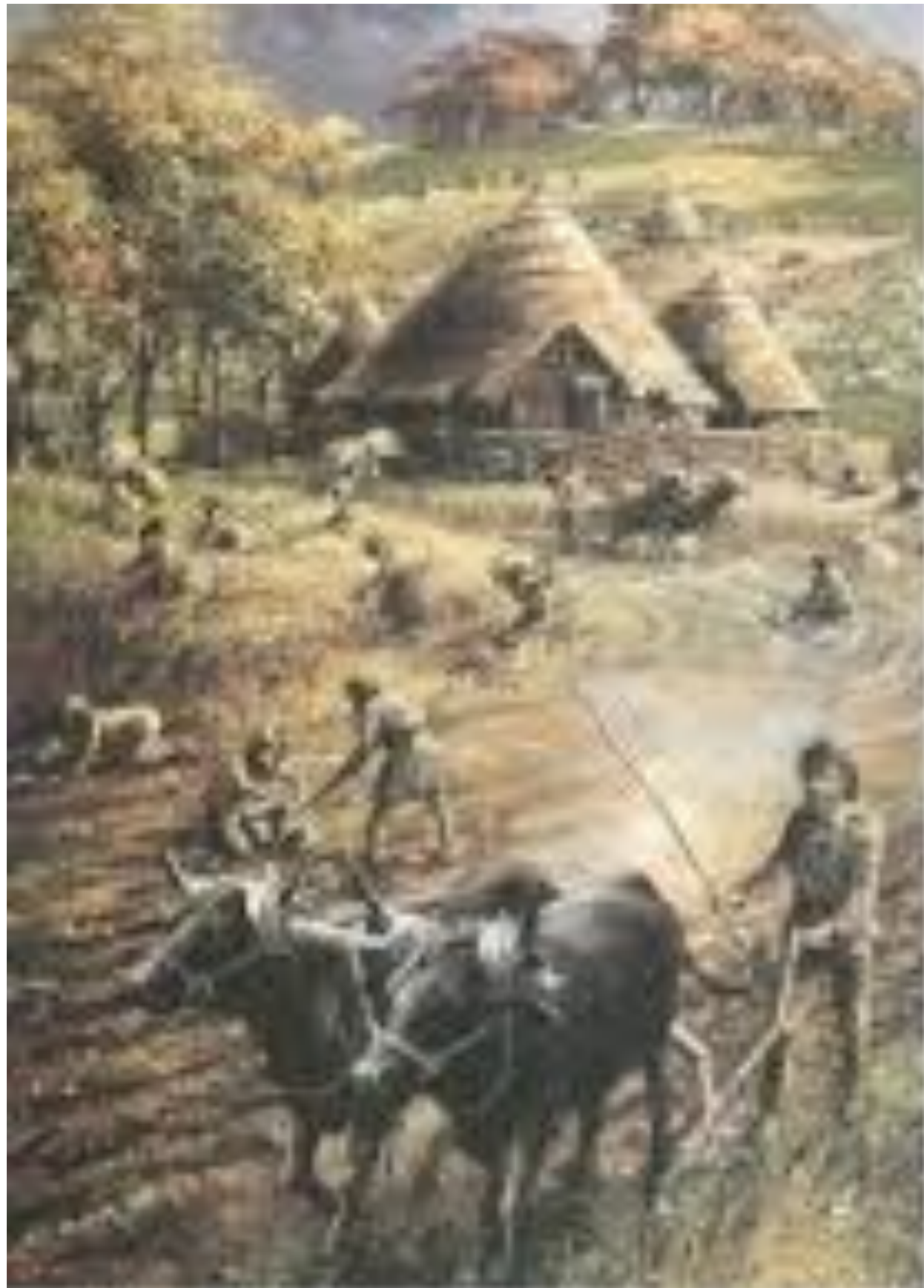




GRADE-VI HISTORY LESSON-3 EARLY HUMANS-II

- In the beginning of the Neolithic Age, people began to **domesticate**, or tame, animals.

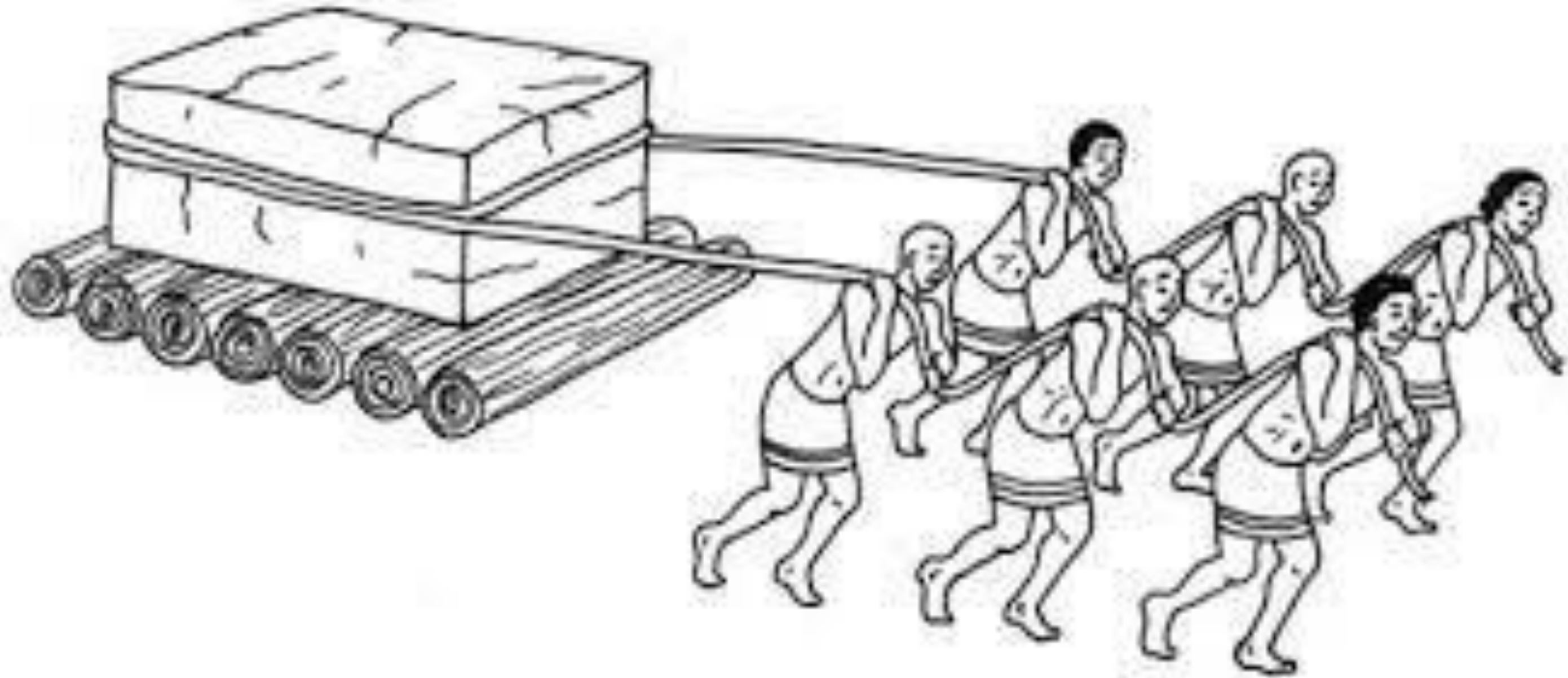
Why would having domesticated animals be a good thing? Write down three reasons that you can think of.

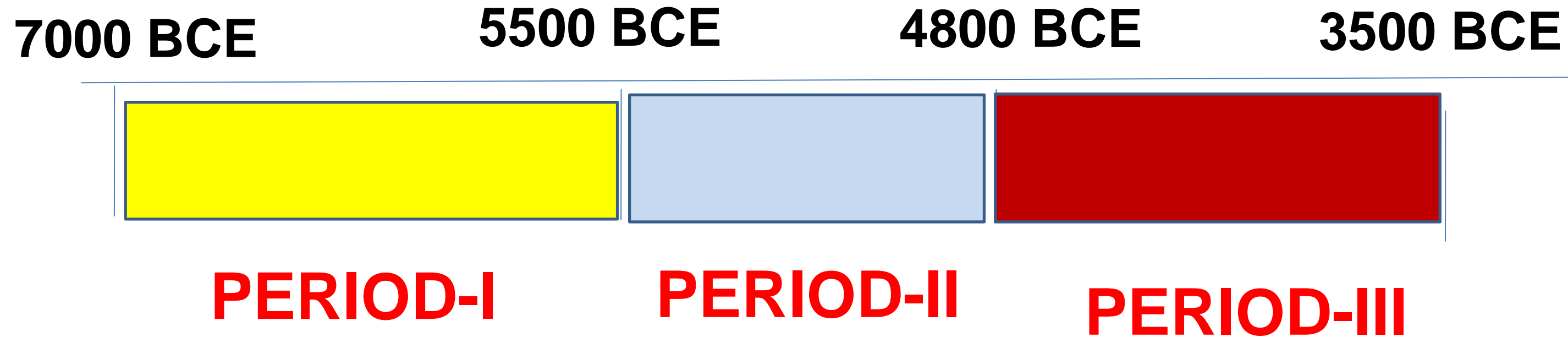
