

# Noun kinds



## 1. Proper

Proper noun refers to the name of a specific person, place & things. examples: Miss Jane, Smith, Antarctica, Samsung,

## 2. Common

A name for an unspecified place, person, or thing examples: Book, Car, Temple, Lamp, Subway, Teacher etc.

## 3.Collective

A collective noun indicates a group of individuals, things. examples: battalion, crew, committee, audience team etc.

## 4. Abstract

An abstract noun expresses feelings, emotion, expression examples: anger, happiness, truth etc.

## 5. Material

A materialist noun is a noun that describes the name of the material examples: money, aluminum, gold, etc.

# Noun numbers

Singular Number – A noun that denotes one person or thing is to be considered in Singular Number.


Plural Number - A noun that denotes more than one person or thing is to be considered in Plural Number.

E.g: sugar, information, water, understanding, etc

# Always take singular verbs
