Part of Speech	Function	Examples
Nouns	Naming people, places, things & ideas/concepts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Mike</b> owns the fastest <b>car</b></li> <li>• They decided to buy the <b>house</b></li> <li>• I believe in <b>free speech</b></li> </ul>
Adjectives	Describing nouns and pronouns	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• That was an <b>exciting</b> film</li> <li>• The boy in the <b>red</b> jumper is <b>happy</b></li> <li>• This is the <b>longest</b> essay</li> </ul>
Adverbs	Modifying verbs, adjectives & adverbs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• She walked <b>slowly</b></li> <li>• They are <b>extremely</b> poor</li> <li>• The police arrived <b>very quickly</b></li> </ul>
Verbs	Expressing a physical action or state	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Federer <b>plays</b> tennis</li> <li>• The floods <b>are</b> serious</li> <li>• <b>Take</b> your time</li> </ul>
Prepositions	Showing relationships of words and phrases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The book is <b>on</b> the table</li> <li>• He went <b>into</b> the room</li> <li>• I'm <b>against</b> abortion</li> </ul>
Pronouns	Replacing nouns	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• John gave <b>her</b> a gift</li> <li>• Why did <b>you</b> push <b>me</b>?</li> <li>• Please look after <b>yourself</b></li> </ul>
Conjunctions	Joining words, phrases & clauses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• He's tall <b>and</b> slim</li> <li>• I'll wait <b>until</b> she arrives</li> <li>• Tom's sick <b>so</b> he's not here</li> </ul>
Interjections	Showing strong emotions or feelings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Wow</b>, that's brilliant news!</li> <li>• <b>Ouch</b>, that really hurt</li> <li>• <b>Hey!</b> How are you doing?</li> </ul>
