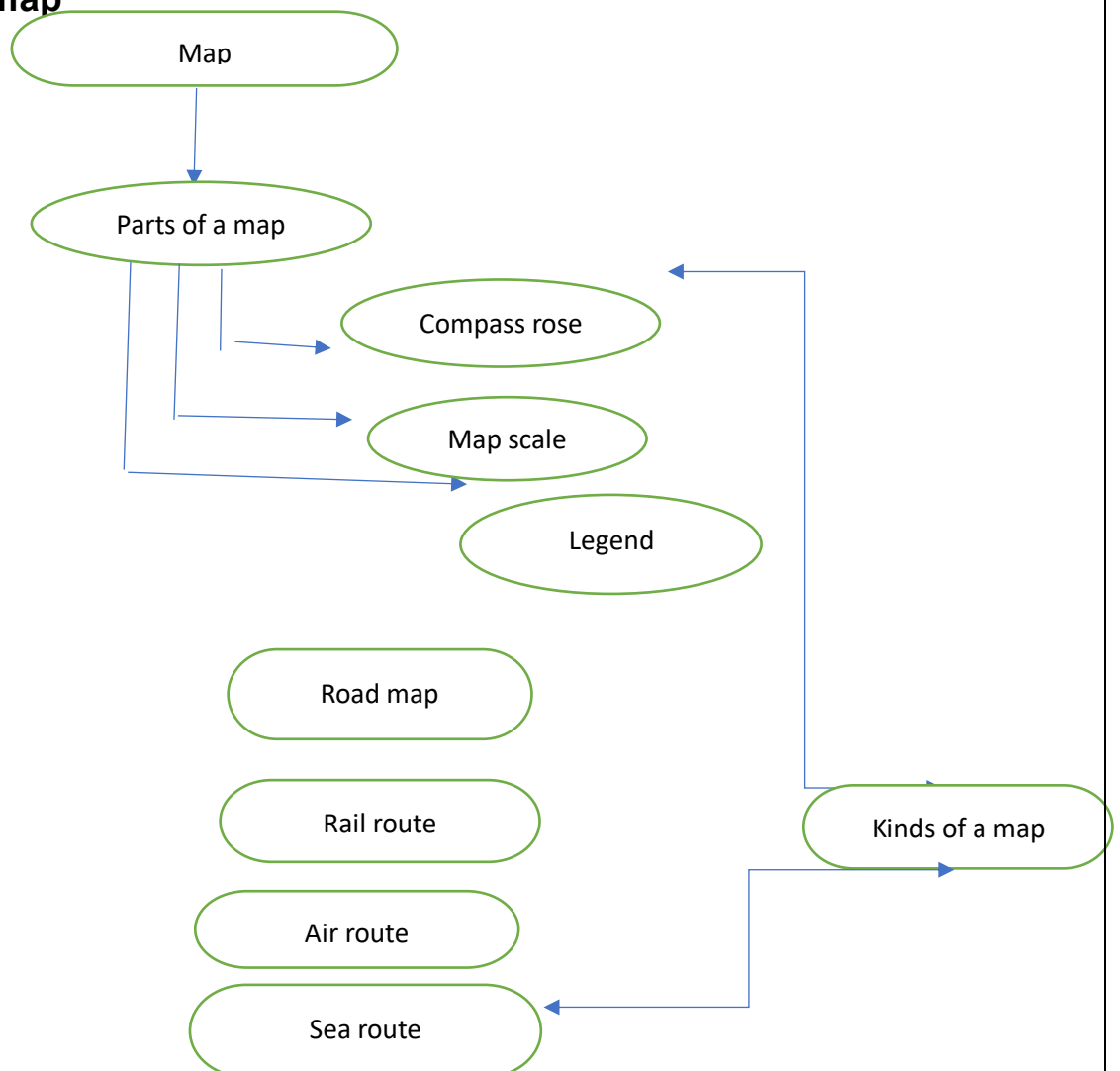

The part of a map refers to the distance on the map to the actual distance on the ground.

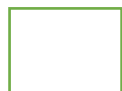
3.what are some symbols that can be shown on a legend?
