2. Which type of seeds will be dispersed by air?

Seeds that have hair like structures or wing like structures and those that are lightweight are dispersed by air. Eg. Dandelion, maple, cotton

3. What is seed dispersal?

The process by which seeds are scattered away from the parent plant is called seed dispersal.

4. Define germination.

The process by which seeds sprout and become young plants is called germination.

5. Which type of seeds are carried by water?

Seeds that are spongy or have outer fibre covering . These plants live along the rivers or streams are dispersed by water.

Eg. Lotus. Lily, coconut
