



• A Good is a physical product that you can see, touch, or possible consume

- Durable Goods --> >= 3 years
- Non-Durable --> <3 years

• A Service is any primary or complementary activity







- Tangible product
- Production usually separate from consumption
- Can be inventoried
- Low customer interaction



Characteristics of services



- Intangible product
- Produced & consumed at same time
- Often unique
- High customer interaction
- Often knowledge-based





GOODS

- 1. Can be resold
- 2. Can be inventoried
- 3. some aspects of quality measurable
- 4. Selling is distinct from production
- 5. Transportable
- 6. Often easy to automate
