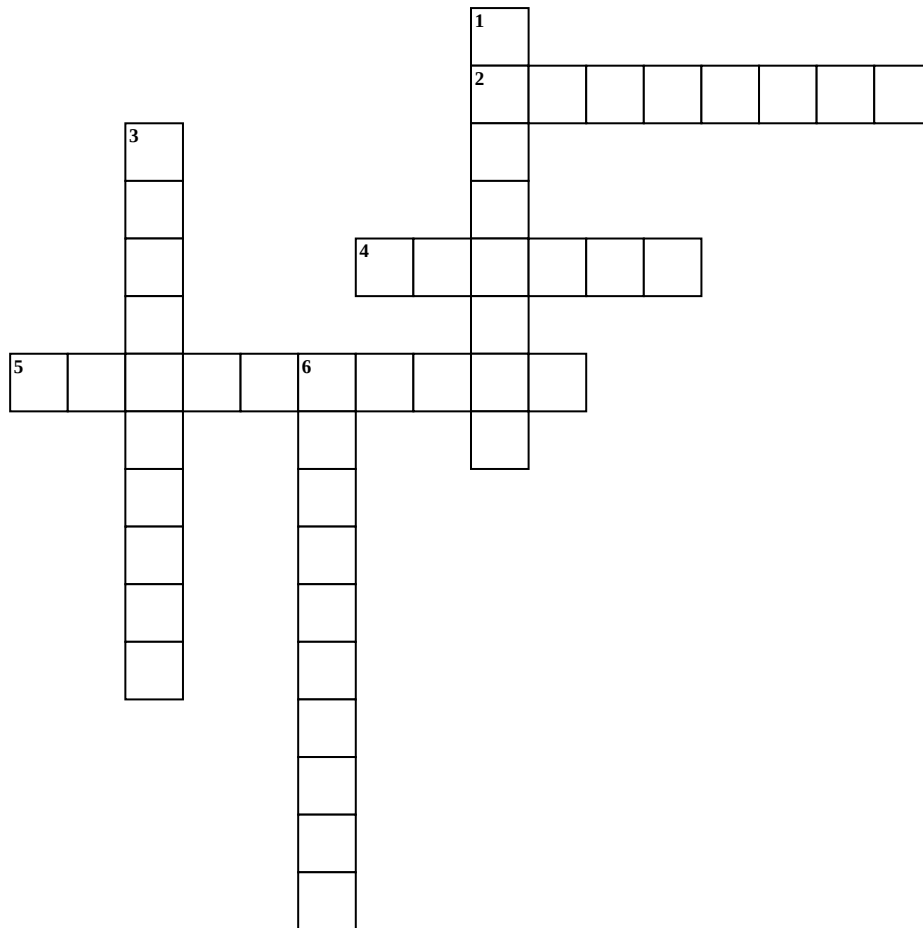


DISORDERS OF BLOOD

[2] Blockage of a blood vessel by a foreign object or blood clot, often causing severe symptoms or even death

[4] Condition where the body lacks sufficient red blood cells or hemoglobin, leading to fatigue and pale skin

[5] Genetic disorder that affects blood clotting, causing prolonged bleeding after injury or surgery

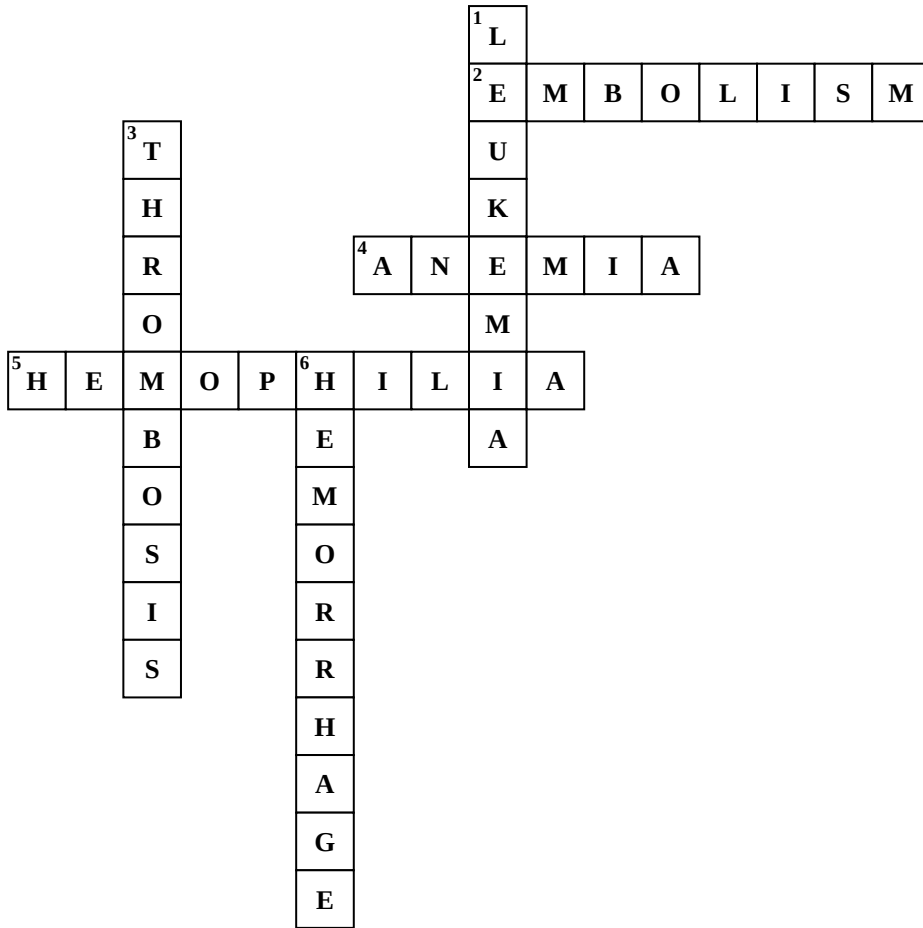
Down

[1] Cancer of the blood or bone marrow, characterized by an abnormal increase in white blood cells

[3] Formation of a blood clot in a blood vessel, often causing pain, swelling, and potentially life-threatening complications

[6] Excessive bleeding caused by damage to a blood vessel, often requiring emergency medical attention
