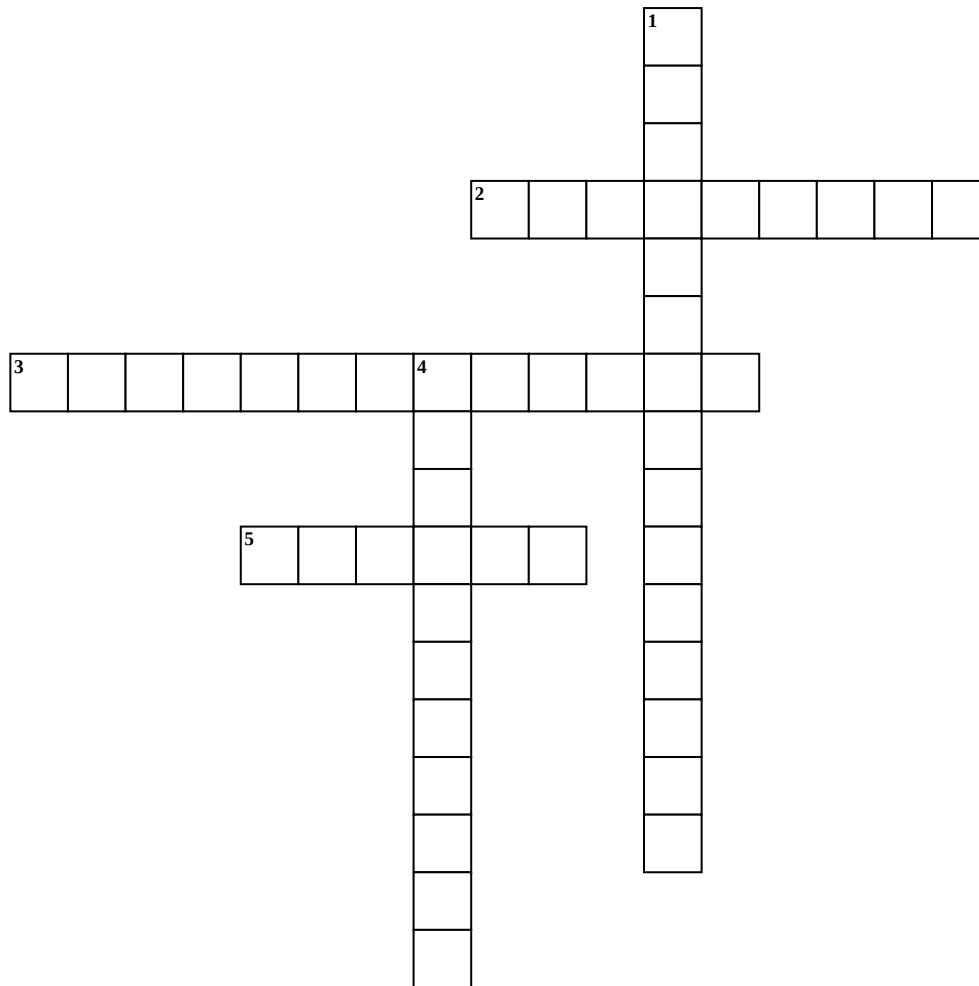


DISORDERS OF CARDIOVASCULAR SYSTEM



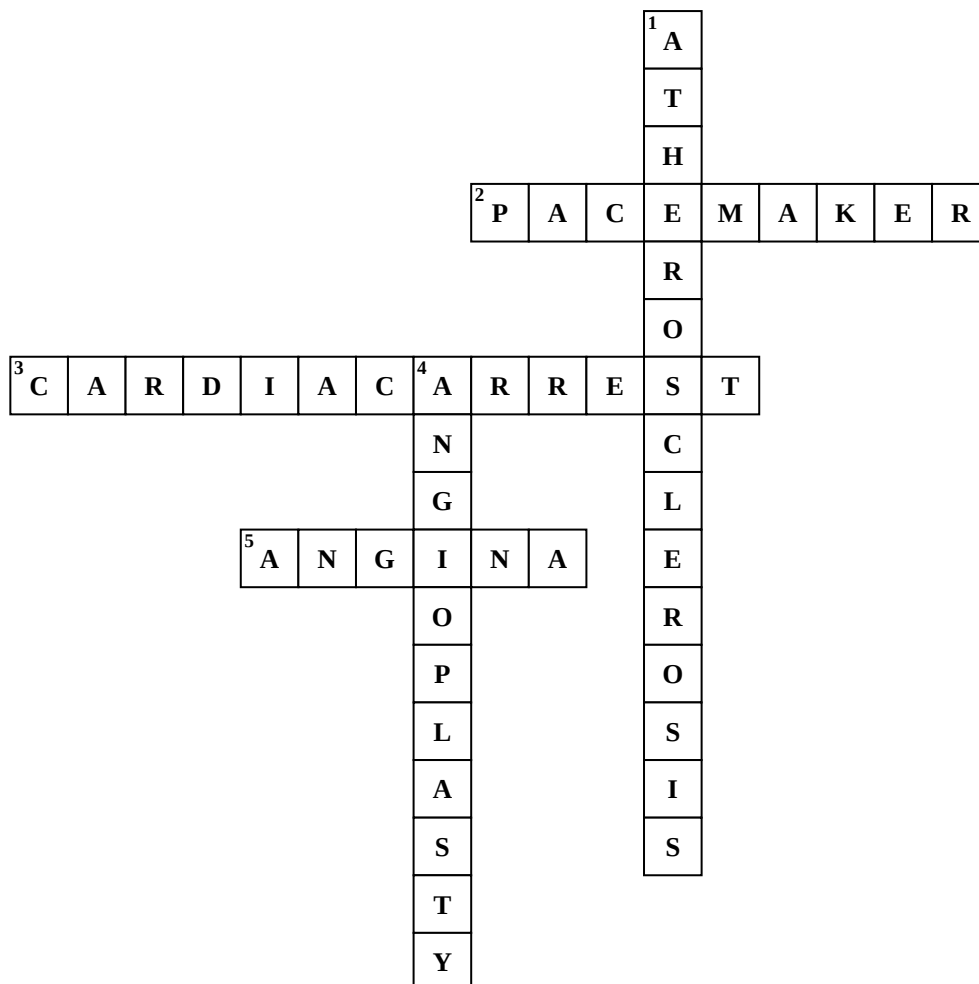
Across

- [2]** Device implanted in the chest to regulate a person's heartbeat and maintain a normal rhythm
- [3]** Sudden stop of the heart's functioning, often requiring immediate medical attention
- [5]** Pain or discomfort in the chest, caused by reduced blood flow to the heart muscle, often due to coronary artery disease

Down

- [1]** Progressive buildup of plaque in the arteries, leading to narrowing and hardening of the vessels, often causing cardiovascular disease
- [4]** Minimally invasive procedure to open blocked coronary arteries using a balloon and/or stent
