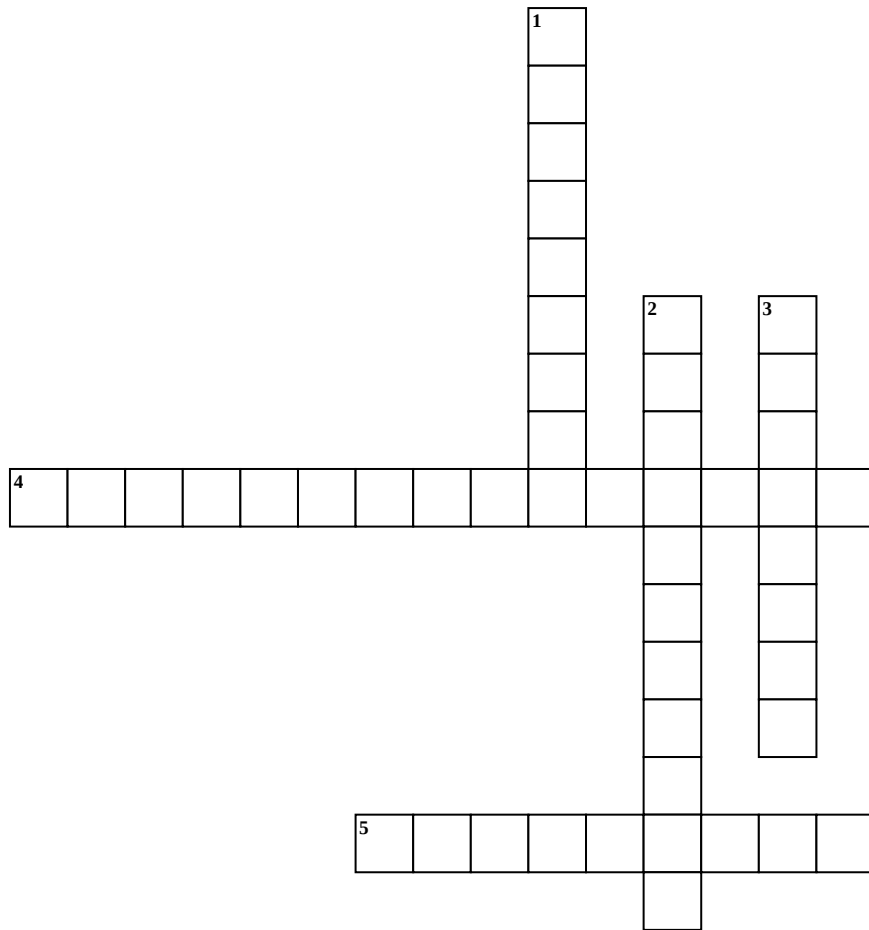


DISORDERS OF LIVER



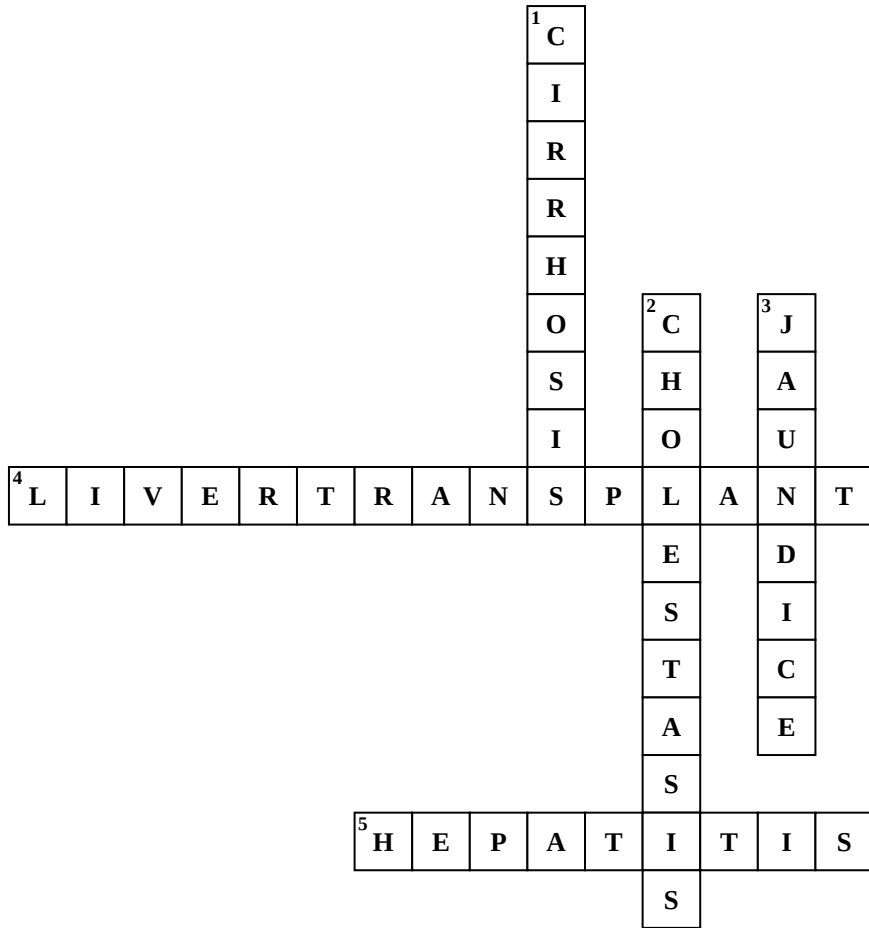
Across

- [4]** Surgical procedure to replace a diseased or damaged liver with a healthy one from a donor or living donor
- [5]** Inflammation of the liver caused by viral infections, autoimmune disorders, or toxic substances

Down

- [1]** Chronic liver disease characterized by scarring and fibrosis of the liver tissue, often caused by alcoholism, hepatitis, or other factors
- [2]** Blockage of the bile ducts, preventing bile from flowing into the small intestine and causing jaundice and other symptoms
- [3]** Yellowing of the skin and whites of the eyes due to elevated bilirubin levels in the blood, often caused by liver disease or obstruction
