TOPIC: BRONCHOSPASM



- *Light anaesthesia, secretions and noxious stimuli can induce bronchospasm*

Treatment:

- *Good depth of anaesthesia*
- *Bronchodilators*
- *Light anaesthesia during lord's stretching and cervical dilatation can initiate parasympathetic over activity cause laryngospasm, bronchospasm, bradycardia and even cardiac arrest.*
- *This reflex is called as bruer lockhart reflex.*
