TOPIC:BRONCHOSPASM



Light anaesthesia, secretions and noxious stimuli can induce bronchospasm



Treatment:

- Good depth of anaesthesia
- Bronchodilators
- Light anaesthesia during lord's stretching and cervical dilatation can initiate parasympathetic over activity cause laryngospasm,bronchospasm,badycardia and even cardiac arrest.
- This reflex is called as bruer lockhart reflex.
