Introduction

- Exposure keratitis is common complication of general anaesthesia if eyes remain open
- Carcarina damage due to inadequate eyelid





- To prevent keratitis artificial tears or eye ointment should be instilled and eyes shouldbe covered with eye pad
- Ischemic optic neuropathy is rare but dreadful complication lead to blindness
