# Case Study Puzzle — "The Dropped Cup Mystery"

## Case Scenario:

A 32-year-old chef, Mr. Arun, arrives at the clinic complaining that he **cannot hold a cup of coffee** with his right hand.

He reports that two days ago, while chopping vegetables, he felt a sudden "shock" on the back of his arm after leaning his upper arm against a metal edge. Since then, he has been unable to extend his wrist and fingers.

## On examination:

- The **wrist hangs flaccidly** when the forearm is outstretched ("wrist drop").
- **Elbow extension is weak** but present.
- **Sensation is lost** over the dorsum of the hand (first web space).
- ➤ The **triceps reflex** is weak.
- No muscle wasting yet.

## **Questions (Detective Tasks)**

- 1. Identify the **primary nerve** affected.
- 2. Name **four muscles** that will be **paralyzed or weakened** because of this injury.
- 3. Determine the **site of lesion** (specific anatomical level) based on the findings.
