1.Content analysis has also been the most commonly used tool in the computer-aided analysis of blogs (web logs), primarily with the intention of trend analysis for the purposes of marketing. While blogs are often considered as "personal publishing" or a "digital diary", bloggers themselves know that blogs are much more than that: modern blogging tools allow to easily comment and react to the comments of other bloggers, resulting in webs of communication among bloggers.1

2. These discussion networks also lead to the establishment of dynamic communities, which often manifest themselves through syndicated blogs (aggregated blogs that collect posts from a set of authors blogging on similar topics), blog rolls (lists of discussion partners on a personal blog) and even result in real world meetings such as the Blog Walk series of meetings.
