TKS - Nature and Type

- The evolution of TKS is very much local in nature and associated with a particular environmental and/or sociocultural context.
- Therefore, TKS has the characteristics of local, empirical, time tested dynamisms.
- Moreover, TKS is always handed over or transferred from one generation to another and also between communities mostly orally and/or visually.





Nature and types of TK

Traditional Knowledge is divided into

- Cultural Knowledge
- Artistic Knowledge
- Medicinal Knowledge
- Biodiversity/ Natural Resources Knowledge
- Agricultural Knowledge
- Sacred Knowledge





Nature and types of TK

From its domain of application and associated management approaches, TKS can be categorised as

- (i) Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK),
- (ii) Traditional Technical Knowledge (TTK) and
- (iii) Traditional Value and Ethics (TVE).
