Sources of Security Threats



Security Threats:

- Any threat (or) connected series of threats to commit (or) intentional attack.
- Against a Computer system for the purpose of demanding Money, Securities (or) other tangible (or) intangible property.



Sources of Security Threats Cont..



Sources:

1. Spoofing Identity (Authentication)
 - Someone else use the password.
2. Tampering with Data (Integrity)
 - Modification of Data. Either Data at rest, (or) data sent over a network.
3. Repudiation (Non – Repudiation)
 - Sending (or) receiving data.
4. Information Disclosure (Confidentiality)
 - User reading data without granted access.
5. Denial of Service (Availability)
 - This relates to the availability of a system.
6. Elevation of Privilege (Authorization)
 - Less privileged user gets higher privileges.
 - Normal user obtaining root privileges.



Sources of Security Threats Cont..



Example:

- Unwanted user reads the files of other user.
- Attacker Modifies the database.
- Remote attacker runs commands on the Server.
