### HTML <embed> Tag

#### Example

An embedded image:

```
<embed type="image/jpg" src="pic_trulli.jpg" width="300" height="200">
```

#### Example

An embedded HTML page:

```
<embed type="text/html" src="snippet.html" width="500" height="200">
```

#### Example

An embedded video:

```
<embed type="video/webm" src="video.mp4" width="400" height="300">
```

### Definition

The `<embed>` tag defines a container for an external resource, such as a web page, a picture, a media player, or a plug-in application.

### Attributes:

Attribute	Value	Description
<a href="#">height</a>	<i>pixels</i>	Specifies the height of the embedded content
<a href="#">src</a>	<i>URL</i>	Specifies the address of the external file to embed
<a href="#">type</a>	<i>media_type</i>	Specifies the media type of the embedded content
<a href="#">width</a>	<i>pixels</i>	Specifies the width of the embedded content
