

Cargo Terminal Layout











Meaning

Cargo terminal is a transportation facility in which quantities of goods or container cargo are stored without undergoing any manufacturing processes, transferred to other carriers or stored outdoors in order to transfer them to other locations.
























An air waybill (AWB) is a legally binding transport document issued by a carrier or agent that provides details about the goods being shipped. It provides detailed information on the contents of the shipment, the sender and recipient, terms and conditions, and other information. The AWB is a standard form that is distributed by the International Air Transport Association (IATA).





Functions of the AWB

The air waybill serves many functions, including:

- Evidence of receipt of goods by an airline
- Contact information among all parties
- Contract of carriage between shipper and carrier
- Freight bill
- Customs declaration
- Description of the goods
- Guide for handling and delivering goods
- Tracking of shipment



Features and Format of the AWB




- 1. It is a One Page Document
- 2. Distributed by the IATA
- 3. It's used in domestic and international shipping
- 4. The document itself is issued in eight sets of different colors, with the first three copies being the original.
- 5. The first original (green) is the issuing carrier's copy.
- 6. The second (pink) is the consignee's copy.
- 7. The third (blue) is the shipper's copy.
- 8. The fourth copy is brown and functions as the receipt and proof of delivery. The other four copies are white.
