OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH SERVICES

➤ Occupational health deals with work-related disorders/diseases and all factors that affect community health within it.

IMPACT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES

- ➤ Reduce absenteeism
- ➤ Identify the help rectify the reasons for poor performance.
- > Prevent work-related illness
- Facilitate early return to work
- > Effectively manage absence etc





IMPACT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES
