Bootstrap provides a set of JavaScript plugins that enable you to add form validation to your web pages easily.

These plugins leverage HTML5 attributes for form validation.

1. Include Bootstrap JS and jQuery: Make sure you include the Bootstrap JS and jQuery libraries in your HTML file.

2. Create a Form:

Design your HTML form as you normally would, ensuring you include appropriate form controls and attributes.

<form id="myForm" class="needs-validation" novalidate> <div class="form-group">

<label for="exampleInputName">Name</label>

<input type="text" class="form-control" id="exampleInputName" placeholder="Enter your name" required>

- <div class="invalid-feedback">
- Please provide a valid name.
- </div>

<button type="submit" class="btn btn-primary">Submit</button></form>



Add Validation Feedback: Use Bootstrap's classes like is-invalid and invalid-feedback to display validation messages.

Initialize Validation: To enable form validation, add the novalidate attribute to your form and include the class needs-validation. This class tells Bootstrap to validate the form on submission.

Customize Validation Rules (Optional): You can customize validation rules using JavaScript if needed, by writing custom validation functions or utilizing Bootstrap's data attributes.

Handle Form Submission: You can handle the form submission using JavaScript or jQuery. Bootstrap will automatically prevent form submission if there are validation errors.

Introduction to JavaScript



JavaScript is a lightweight, cross-platform, single-threaded, and interpreted compiled programming language.

It is also known as the scripting language for webpages.

It is well-known for the development of web pages, and many nonbrowser environments also use it.

JavaScript is a weakly typed language (dynamically typed). JavaScript can be used for Client-side developments as well as Server-side developments







Client-side:

It supplies objects to control a browser and its Document Object Model (DOM).

Like if client-side extensions allow an application to place elements on an HTML form and respond to user events such as mouse clicks, form input, and page navigation.

Useful libraries for the client side are AngularJS, ReactJS, VueJS







Server-side:

It supplies objects relevant to running JavaScript on a server.

For if the server-side extensions allow an application to communicate with a database, and provide continuity of information from one invocation to another of the application, or perform file manipulations on a server.

The useful framework which is the most famous these days is **node.js**.





JavaScript can be added to HTML file in two ways:

Internal JS:

We can add JavaScript **directly to our HTML file** by writing the code inside the **<script> tag.**

The <script> tag can either be placed inside the **<head> or the <body>** tag according to the requirement.

External JS:

We can write JavaScript code in another files having an **extension.js** and then link this file inside the **<head> tag** of the HTML file in which we want to add this code.

Features of JavaScript



JavaScript was created in the first place for **DOM manipulation**. Earlier websites were mostly static, after JS was created dynamic Web sites were made.

Functions in **JS are objects**. They may have properties and methods just like other objects. They can be **passed as arguments in other functions**.

Can handle date and time.

Performs Form Validation although the forms are created using HTML.

No compiler is needed.

Why JavaScript is known as a lightweight programming language?

JavaScript is considered lightweight due to the fact that it has low CPU usage, is easy to implement, and has a minimalist syntax. Minimalist syntax as in, has no data types.

A lightweight language does not consume much of your CPU's resources.

It doesn't put excess strain on your CPU or RAM.

JavaScript runs in the browser even though it has complex paradigms and logic which means it uses fewer resources than other languages







Is JavaScript Compiled or Interpreted or both?

JavaScript is both compiled and interpreted.

In the earlier versions of JavaScript, it used only the interpreter that executed code line by line and shows the result immediately.
