INTRODUCTION



 Puppet is a manipulative doll dressed as a character and the performer is a person termed as

puppeteer.





DEFINITON



 It is an education cum entertaining aid in which puppets manipulated by the performer is a person termed as characters in a story to be depicted.



TYPES



- Hand & glove
- Finger
- Stick, String
- Rod
- Shadow, Water dancing





HAND AND GLOVE



 It is made of a hollow head sewn or glued to material that fits over the head, concealing the fingers and thumb, which manipulate it.





FINGER



- It is controlled by one or more fingers that occupy the interior of the puppets.
- It is generally very simple, consisting of a sheath that the person wearing the puppet inserts either one fingers.



STICK



These are painted cardboard/

paper cutouts attached by sticks.





ROD



❖ They are flat cut out fingers tacked a stick, with one or more movable parts and operated from below the stage level by wire rods or slender sticks.



SHADOW



- These are figures that are placed between a light and screen.
- Moving them creates the illusion of moving images on the screen.
- An experienced puppeteer can make figures appear to walk, talk, fight and dance.



STRING



- ❖ It is controlled from above by rods or strings suspended from a hand held control.
- ❖ The bodies may be made of wood, fabric, paper, foam, rubber.



WATER DANCE



- These puppets are made out of wood and then lacquered and performed in a waist deep pool.
- A large bamboo rod supports the puppets under the water and is used by the puppeteers, who are normally hidden behind a screen to control them.



PRINCIPLES



- Plays must be based on action rather than words.
- A puppet show should not have many characters.
- Songs are speech from the back or recorded talk are used.
- The actual voices of men, women, and children can be limited.



PREPARATION



- Prepare a script for the play.
- The story should involve conversation between the character, it should be humorous and entertaining.
- Each message idea or point of view should be introduced and developed in a logical order.



ADVANTAGES



- They boost active participating among students getting attentions.
- Fascination of the inanimate objects.
- Enjoyable and spontaneous learning experiences.
- Students become more creative.



DISADVANTAGES



- Time consuming.
- It is expensive.
- It requires skill in preparation and in presentation.
- It need group co-operation and co-ordination.
- Seating arrangement is to be managed carefully.
