INTRODUCTION



- Assessment can focus on the individual learner, the learning community (class, workshop, or other organized group of learners), the institution, or the educational system.
- Assess comes from latin verb "assidere" meaning 'to sit with'.





DEFINITION



 In assessment one is supposed to sit with the learner. This implies it is something we do 'with' and 'for' students and not 'to' students. – Green, 1999.



PURPOSE



- To provide short term goals to students.
- To clarify the intended learning outcome.
- To determine the level of knowledge & understanding in students.
- To diagnose the strengths & weakness of students.






- To encourage students learning by measuring their achievement.
