

Set 3 – Mnemonics

Mnemonic for Autism Features: “A-LONE”

- **A** – Abnormal communication
- **L** – Lack of social interaction
- **O** – Odd/repetitive behaviors
- **N** – Narrow interests
- **E** – Early onset

Mnemonic for ADHD Symptoms: “MOAT”

- **M** – Motor hyperactivity
- **O** – Organizational difficulties
- **A** – Attention deficit
- **T** – Talkative/impulsive

Column A (Disorder)	Column B (Characteristic)
Autism	Impaired social interaction, repetitive behavior
ADHD	Inattention, hyperactivity, impulsivity
Dyslexia	Difficulty in reading and writing
Anorexia nervosa	Extreme restriction of food intake, low body wt.
Bulimia nervosa	Binge eating followed by purging
Conduct disorder	Aggressive and rule-breaking behavior
Intellectual disability	Low IQ, impaired adaptive functioning
Learning disorder	Difficulty in academic skills (reading, math)
