Synonyms: Gambier

- Biological source: Dried aqueous extract of leaves & young twigs of <u>Uncaria gambier</u>.
- > Family: Rubiaceae.
- ➤ Geo.source: India, Bangladesh, Singapore & Indonesia.
- Macroscopic character:
 - > Shape: Cuboidal
 - Colour: Reddish browl

Macroscopic character:

Odour: odourless

Taste: Astringent

Fracture: Uneven

Special features: Brittle in nature, easily soluble in nature.



Preparation procedure:

Leaves & twigs are collected & boiled with water.

Extract is filtered & cooled.

During cooling sen solid pasty mass formed.

Placed in different dies.
