PRESCRIPTION

A prescription is an order for medicine which a doctor writes, and which is given to a pharmacist to prepare and administer the medicine.

Parts of a prescription

- Date,
- Name,age,sex & address of the patient,
- Superscription,
- Inscription,
- Subscription,
- Signature (Sig),
- Signature, address & Registration number of prescriber,

Superscription

- This is the Rx symbol on the prescription form that designates the written document to be a prescription.
- Rx is an abbreviation for a Latin phrase that means "take thou."

Inscription

- It includes the drug name, concentration and type of preparation.
- Drug names should not be abbreviated and correct spelling is important to assure that the correct medication is dispensed.

Subscription

• It is the instruction to the pharmacist, usually consisting of a short sentence such as: "dispense 30 tablets."

Signa or "Sig"

• It is the instruction for the patient as to how to take the **prescription**,interpreted and transposed onto the **prescription** label by the pharmacist.

Role of pharmacist in prescription

- Ensuring that the good quality of medicines supplied to patients.
- Ensuring that the medicines prescribed to patients are suitable.
- Advising patients about medicines, including how to take them,
 what reactions may occur. Answering patients' questions.

General errors in prescription

Any step in the prescribing process can generate errors. Slips, lapses, or mistakes are sources of errors. The errors may be,

- Unintended omissions in the transcription of drugs,
- Faults in dose selection,
- omitted transcription,
- Poor handwriting.
