Massage Therapy Case Scenario Puzzles

1. Puzzle 1 – Oedema after Fracture

A 30-year-old male presents with post-immobilization swelling in his ankle after cast removal. He has no signs of DVT.

Which massage technique is most appropriate to reduce the swelling?

2. Puzzle 2 – Facial Paralysis

A 45-year-old woman with sudden onset deviation of the mouth and inability to close her eye is diagnosed with Bell's palsy.

Which specific massage strokes are indicated for facial muscles?

3. Puzzle 3 – Sports Recovery

A sprinter complains of muscle tightness in the quadriceps after a 200m race. What category of sports massage (pre-event, intermediate, post-event) should be applied, and which strokes are best?

4. Puzzle 4 – Contraindication Check

A patient with deep vein thrombosis (DVT) asks for leg massage to reduce pain. Should massage be given? Why or why not?

5. Puzzle 5 – Painful Neuroma

A patient with amputation reports pain at the stump region diagnosed as painful neuroma.

Which massage method can be used to desensitize the area?

6. **Puzzle 6 – Relaxation**

An anxious patient with insomnia visits physiotherapy.

Which massage strokes (light stroking vs. percussion) will help relaxation, and why?

7. Puzzle 7 – Fibrositis

A 40-year-old office worker complains of localized muscle pain with palpable nodules in the trapezius.

Which massage technique is most effective—effleurage, petrissage, or friction?
