



BREACH OF CONTRACT

A breach of contract occurs if any party refuses or fails to perform his part of the contract.









A Breach of contract may arise in two ways

ACTUAL BREACH ANTICIPATORY BREACH







ANTICIPATORY BREACH



Anticipatory Breach" An anticipatory breach occurs when a party demonstrates his intention to break a contract"







ACTUAL BREACH



This may take place in any of the following two ways:

Actual Breach

On due date of performance

During the course of performance



SUIT FOR RECESSION





 In such cases, if one party has broken his contractual relations, the other party may treat the breach as discharge and refuse to perform his part of performance.













Damages are a monetary compensation allowed to the injured party for the loss or injury suffered by him as a result of the breach of contract

- 1. Ordinary Damage
- 2. Special
- 3. Exemplary
- 4. Nominal











- □ It means "AS MUCH AS EARNED" or "in proportion to the work done."
- □ Right to 'Quantum Meruit' literally means a right to claim the compensation for the work already done









SUIT FOR SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE

Suit for Specific performance means demanding the court's direction to the defaulting party to carry out the promise according to the terms of contract.
