






What is a Cloze Test?



- A test in which one is asked to supply words that have been removed from a passage in order to measure one's ability to comprehend text.
- A cloze test is an exercise where a passage is provided with certain words missing from it.
- Actually it is a combination of fill in the blanks and reading comprehension. It is important to understand the flow and context of a passage.



STRUCTURE



- Cloze reading test can be multiple choice, where you may be required to choose from a list of words to "fill in" the blanks,
- or be required to select the best word to complete the sentence based on your vocabulary skills.



Tips to handle Cloze test



- Read thoroughly
- Link the sentences together
- Type of word to fill in
- Key words

Finally, the reviewer can give a rating to the book.
