- Chilli is the major spice crop grown in India.
- Around 29% of the area under cultivation is that of chilli.
- Chilli contributes around 37% of the whole spices produced in India.
- Cumin contributes around 17% of the total spice produced in India.
- Turmeric contributes around 10% of the total spice produced in India.
- Ginger contributes around 8% of the total spice produced in India.
- In 2020-21 India produced 10.7 million tonnes of spices.
- In 2020-21, India exported spices worth around the US \$4.18 billion.
- The spices produced in India are exported to China, US, Vietnam, Thailand, Bangladesh, UAE, UK, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, Indonesia, and Germany.
