FLOW CHART



- A flowchart is a diagram showing the development of something through different stages or processes.
- It's a step-by-step approach to solving a task.



PIE CHART



- A pie chart is a circular statistical graphic, which is divided into slices to illustrate numerical proportion.
- In a pie chart, the arc length of each slice, is proportional to the quantity it represents.



BAR CHART

- A bar chart is a diagram on which narrow bands of equal width but varying height are used to represent quantities.
- Bar charts are best used to compare a single category of data or several.
