


IDIOMS

they have hidden meanings.









What is an idiom?

A 'night owl' is an idiom.

If we say that Franz is a 'night owl', we don't mean that he actually is an owl!



The words in the idiom



An idiom is a group of words that have a special meaning when used together. The meaning of the idiom is different from the meaning of the individual words. Shakespeare used and invented lots of idioms.



The meaning of the idiom



IDIOMS

Example :

"A Fish out of water"

Meaning: Uncomfortable Situation

Example: "When Danny first moved to the big city from the countryside, he was like a fish out of water."





IDIOMS

Example :

"A Left Handed Complement"

Meaning: Something pleasant about someone but can also be an insult.









Example :

"Every Cloud has a Silver Lining"

Meaning: Every bad situation holds the possibility of something good.







PHRASES

What is Phrases?

- A phrase is a group of words that work together to convey a specific meaning.
- But unlike a complete sentence, a phrase does not contain a ulletsubject and a predicate (a verb or verb phrase).
- Phrases are commonly used in language to express ideas, provide lacksquaredescriptions, or add detail to a sentence.
