State Election commission



- States Election Commission (India) is an autonomous and Constitutional body constituted in States and Union Territories of India for ensuring that elections are conducted in free, fair and unbiased way.
- Constitution of India with provisions as per Article 324 safeguards the powers of Election Commission.
- States Election Commission in India are responsible for elections for Urban Local Bodies like Municipalities, Municipal Corporations, Panchayats and any other specified by Election Commission of India.
- They are appointed by Governor of state or union territory.



State Election commission:Role

- Conducting elections for Municipal Corporations in State.
- Conducting elections for Municipal panchayats in State.
- Model code of conduct implemented in elections for local bodies.
- Updating Electoral rolls with new additions.
- Updating Electoral rolls with removals, if any



Functions

- Function as a Grievance Redressal Cell for the grievances of SC/ST/OBC students and employees of the Institution and render them necessary help in solving their academic and administrative problems.
- To deal with the representations received from Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Castes candidates regarding their admission, recruitment, promotion and other similar matters in the Institution.
- To circulate Government of India orders and Commission's decisions and to collect information in respect of appointment, training of these communities in teaching and non-teaching posts in the Institution in suitable forms by a stipulated date and take follow up action where required.
