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


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USING A, AN, THE

- A is used in front of singular countable nouns (a person, animal or thing) which are not specific.
- We don't use a before uncountable or plural nouns.
- If a noun starts with a consonant sound (b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, etc.), "a" comes before the noun.
- Examples: a cat a bird a child
 - a doctor

 An is used in front of singular countable nouns which are not specific.


An

- We don't use an before uncountable or plural nouns.
- If the noun starts with a vowel sound (a, e, i, o, u), "an" comes before the noun.
- Examples:
 - an apple an egg an ant an orange

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ARTICLES - A, AN, THE

Articles – a, an, the

Use a, an for one out of many

Use a when the noun begins with a consonant Example: a bag a cat

Exception: When the vowel u sounds like you.

Example: a university

a utensil

Use an when the noun begins with a vowel Example: an apple an umbrella

Exception: When the consonant h is silent.

Example: an hour an honor

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Use the for a specific item

Example:

The umbrella in the bag The cat in the tree
